"RETROSTEM" project, launched back in October 2018, has been targeting educators, teachers and trainers aiming to enhance their digital literacy and competences. The project was designed and put into implementation under the 2016 Council Resolution on "A New Skills Agenda for an Inclusive and Competitive Europe" stating that skills are the pathway to employability and prosperity.

Ever since, the consortium, consisting of CIVIC (UK), Emphasys (Cyprus), CCSDE (Ireland), Lodz University of Technology (Poland), MIRCEA (Romania) and EA (Greece), has been consistently working on the delivery of RETROSTEM console and the constant improvement of its technical capacities.
